Qualification, Description, and Information of Award Nominations

1. Constable of the Year

This award will go to a Constable that over time or the past year has: shown or achieved outstanding and notable actions in their office, community, state or nation highlighting service to their area citizens; inspired greatness to others; commitment to fellow citizens; dedication to fairness and humanity; gone above and beyond the duties of their office, shown attention to detail and outstanding work ethics; provided and/or promoted services or events to raise awareness to a cause to benefit citizens or fellow officers. They must be a paid member and the nominator must be a paid member.

2. Marshal of the Year

This award will go to a Marshal that over time or the past year has: shown or achieved outstanding and notable actions in their office, community, state or nation highlighting service to their area citizens; inspired greatness to others; commitment to fellow citizens; dedication to fairness and humanity; gone above and beyond the duties of their office, shown attention to detail and outstanding work ethics; provided and/or promoted services or events to raise awareness to a cause to benefit citizens or fellow officers. They must be a paid member and the nominator must be a paid member.

3. Deputy Constable of the Year

This award will go to a Deputy Constable or other rank under their Constable that over time or the past year has: shown or achieved outstanding and notable actions in their office, community, state or nation highlighting service to their area citizens; inspired greatness to others; commitment to fellow citizens; dedication to fairness and humanity; gone above and beyond the duties of their office, shown attention to detail and outstanding work

ethics; provided and/or promoted services or events to raise awareness to a cause to benefit citizens or fellow officers. They must be a paid member and the nominator must be a paid member.

4. Deputy Marshal of the Year

This award will go to a Deputy Marshal or other rank under their Constable that over time or the past year has: shown or achieved outstanding and notable actions in their office, community, state or nation highlighting service to their area citizens; inspired greatness to others; commitment to fellow citizens; dedication to fairness and humanity; gone above and beyond the duties of their office, shown attention to detail and outstanding work ethics; provided and/or promoted services or events to raise awareness to a cause to benefit citizens or fellow officers. They must be a paid member and the nominator must be a paid member.

5. Clerk of the Year

This award will go to a clerk or support staff member that, over time or the past year, has shown or achieved outstanding and notable actions in their office, community, the NCMA, or has gone above and beyond the duties of their office, shown attention to detail and an outstanding work ethic. They must be a paid member and the nominator must be a paid member.

6. Outstanding Service Award

This individual may show or shown outstanding service to the National Constables and Marshals Association. They must be a paid member and the nominator must be a paid member. More than one award may be presented in this category.

7. Exceptional Service Award

This individual may show or shown outstanding service to their office or community. They must be a paid member and the nominator must be a paid member. More than one award may be presented in this category.

8. Community Service Award

This individual has shown outstanding, innovative and groundbreaking service to their community. They must be a paid member and the nominator must be a paid member. More than one award may be presented in this category.
